1. Introduction

This document describes errata and clarifications for the TCG PC Client Platform Firmware Profile (PFP) Specification revision 1.03 version 51 as published. The information in this document is likely – but not certain – to be incorporated into a future version of the specification. Suggested fixes proposed in this document may be modified before being published in a later TCG Specification. Therefore, the contents of this document are not normative and only become normative when included in an updated version of the published specification. Note that since the errata in this document are non-normative, the patent licensing rights granted by Section 16.4 of the Bylaws do not apply.

2. Errata

2.1 Errata 1

Section 9.4.1 Table 9 contains text which is incorrect. The EV_EVENT_TAG description states it is not permitted for use by Platform FW. This contradicts section 9.4.2 which requires EV_EVENT_TAG for a TCG_PCClientTaggedEvent structure. This structure and EV_EVENT_TAG may be used by platform firmware to measure Legacy Option ROMs.

2.2 Errata 2

Section 9.4.3, in the first paragraph of the normative text, a requirement incorrectly uses the phrase “nul” terminator. Per the Terms and Definitions for this specification, this should be interpreted as “NUL” terminator.

2.3 Errata 3

Section 9.4.5.1 Table 15, the description for the TCG_Efi_SpecIdEvent Signature “The NUL-terminated ASCII string “SpecIDEvent03”” does not match the provided hexadecimal representation in the same description. This string text is also used in the informative in Section 9.1. The hexadecimal representation is correct and the string should be “Spec ID Event03”.

2.4 Errata 4

In Section 9.4.2 Table 10, the first element in the table has a typographic error in the Name column. The Name “taggedEvent ID” should be interpreted as “taggedEventID”.
